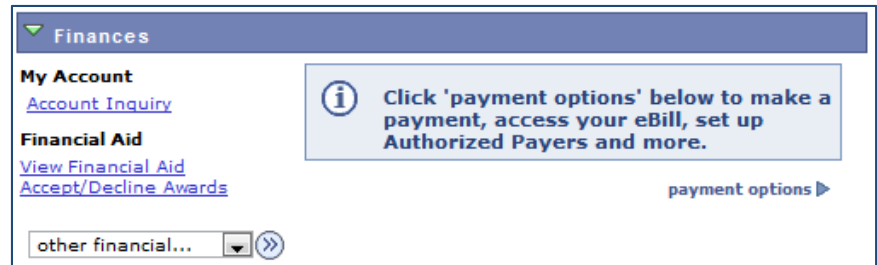




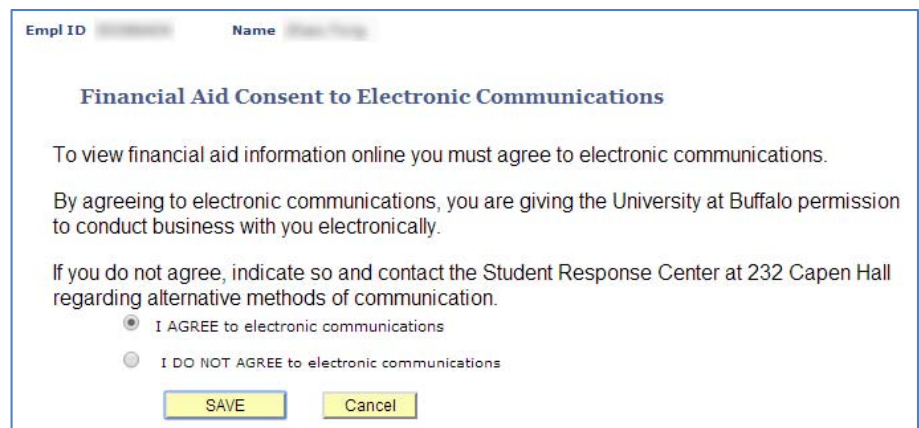
Using the Student Center: View Financial Aid

The Student Center is a self-service page that provides students an entry to the HUB. Along with MyUB, it provides navigation to tools and information that are important to you. To reach the Student Center click the Student Center tab from MyUB. In this tutorial we will review the information you can find in the Financial Aid section of the Student Center.



In the Finances group box, under the Financial Aid heading, click the Accept/Decline Awards link.

The first time you access your Financial Aid information through the Student Center using either the View Financial Aid or Accept/Decline awards links, a Financial Aid Consent to Electronic Communications screen will appear. Read the information on the screen, and select the radio button to the left of your designation.



**If you select “I DO NOT AGREE to electronic communications” follow the instructions on the screen and contact the appropriate office. After you click SAVE you will be brought to the Student Center main page.

**If you select “I AGREE to electronic communications” and click SAVE you will be brought to the Terms and conditions screen.

NOTE: For privacy reasons, all of the sensitive student information has been masked from these screens.

Read the Terms and Conditions.

Every time you access Accept/Decline Financial Aid Awards, you will need to complete the Terms and Conditions steps.

Click the radio button indicating that you have read and understand these award terms and conditions.

To go to the Financial Aid, Select Aid Year to View screen click the Continue button



Financial Aid Terms and Conditions

As a financial aid recipient at the University at Buffalo, I understand that I am responsible for the following financial aid terms and conditions. I further understand for my own protection that I will be required to provide proof of my identity as required by FERPA when calling on the telephone, e-mailing or visiting an in-person site:

- Telephone - You will be asked various questions from the FAFSA to prove your identity.
- E-mail - all email correspondence from the student must be sent through their UB email account. Email communication from parents must match the email address provided on the FAFSA.
- In-person - Valid photo identification will be required.

1. Please note that you must file the FAFSA each year by March 1, if you wish to be considered for campus-based funds, such as Federal Work-Study, Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (SEOG), and Perkins, and by May 1 for Health Professions Loans. UB school code is 002837. Refer to the [Frequently Asked Questions](#) site for additional information.
2. Students must be enrolled in a matriculated degree program for federal financial aid eligibility. Once all the requirements for a degree are completed you will no longer be eligible for federal financial aid.
3. New and transfer undergraduate students must provide a final official high school transcript to the Admissions Office. Failure to submit the transcript will prohibit the disbursement of financial aid.
